National Donut Day (also known as <u>National Doughnut Day</u>) on November 5th is one of two observed by donut lovers across the nation. The first Friday in June is the other day donuts steal the bakery case spotlight ready to tease their way into white bakery box and go home!

History disputes the origin of the donut. One theory suggests Dutch settlers brought donuts to North America much like they brought other traditional American desserts. They receive credit for such desserts as the apple pie, cream pie and cobbler.

Donut shapes are as varied as their history. Was the original donut round? If so, American Hanson Gregory laid claim to inventing the ring-shaped donut in 1847 while working onboard a lime-trading ship. Only 16 at the time, Gregory claims he punched a hole in the center of dough with the ship's tin pepper box. Later, he taught the technique to his mother.

Traveling further back in time, we look at an English cookbook. According to anthropologist Paul R. Mullins, an 1803 volume included donuts in the appendix of American recipes. However, the earliest recorded usage of the term donut is found in a short story in a Boston Times article about "fire-cakes and dough-nuts" published in 1808.

A more commonly cited first written recording of the word is Washington Irving's reference to donuts in 1809 in his *History of New York*. He described balls of sweetened dough, fried in hog's fat. The author called them donuts. Today, these nuts of fried dough are called donut holes.

Another author, William Cullen Bryant describes donuts fried in lard in his book *Picturesque America*; *Or, the Land We Live In* which was published in 1872.

Donut versus Doughnut

•Print ads for cake and glazed donuts and doughnuts existed from at least 1896 in the United States.

•George W. Peck published *Peck's Bad Boy and his Pa* in 1900. It contained the first known printed use of donut. In it, a character is quoted as saying, "Pa said he guessed he hadn't got much appetite, and he would just drink a cup of coffee and eat a donut."

•In 1919, the Square Donut Company of America was founded. Square donuts offer an easier-to-package product.

The more traditional spelling is doughnut. However, both doughnut and donut are pervasive in American English.

Donuts come in a large variety of recipes, flavors and toppings. However, just like many pastries, we are only limited by imagination and the ingredients at hand. From syrups and jellies to sprinkles and custards, top them, fill them, bake them or fry them. Donuts have a mouth-watering way of glazing and dusting their way into our shopping carts. They also slip into the break room at work to share.

PUMPKIN CRISP

Shortbread Crust

- •1 1/2 cups all purpose flour
- •1/4 cup granulated sugar
- •1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- •2 teaspoons ground ginger
- •1/2 cup cold butter *cubed

Crumble Topping

- •1 cup all purpose flour
- •1/2 cup granulated sugar
- •1/2 cup packed brown sugar *either light or dark
- •1 teaspoon cinnamon
- •1/2 cup rolled oats
- •1 teaspoon baking powder
- •1/2 cup chopped pecans
- •1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- •1 large egg *whisked
- •6 tablespoons butter *melted

Shortbread Crust In a medium sized mixing bowl combine flour, sugar, cinnamon and ginger. Mix well. Using a pastry cutter cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Press into an ungreased 13x9 inch baking pan. Set aside. **Pumpkin Layer** Preheat oven to 425°F. Mix together the sugar, cinnamon, ginger, cloves and salt in a small bowl. In a separate bowl whisk eggs. In a large mixing bowl using a hand mixer (or stand mixer), beat pumpkin with eggs. Add sugar and beat well making sure to scrape down sides of bowl. Gradually beat in sweetened condensed milk scraping down sides of bowl often. Pour pumpkin mixture over shortbread crust. Bake at 425°F for 15 mins. Lower temperature of oven to 350°F and continue baking for 30-35 minutes or until pumpkin is mostly set. **Crumble Topping** In a medium sized mixing bowl add flour, sugars, cinnamon, baking powder, rolled oats and pecans. Stir well. To the bowl add vanilla and egg. Stir until the moisture of the egg and vanilla are evenly distributed and the mixture becomes crumbly. Raise temperature of oven to 400°F. Sprinkle crumble mixture evenly over the top of the pumpkin and drizzle with melted butter. Bake for 20 mins or until crumble topping is golden brown and cake tester comes out clean when inserted into the center of the crisp. Let cool completely at room temperature. Top with ice cream or freshly made whipped cream. Store leftovers covered in the refrigerator. Serves 15







NORTH DAKOTA GAME & FISH

Deer Season Questions and Answers

Every year the North Dakota Game and Fish Department receives <u>questions from deer hunters</u> to clarify rules and regulations. Some common questions are listed below. Hunters with further questions are encouraged to visit the Game and Fish Department's website, <u>gf.nd.gov</u>., or call 701-328-6300, from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. weekdays.

I have a concurrent season license. When can I use it? The license can be used during archery season with a bow; deer gun season with a bow, rifle or muzzleloader; or the muzzleloader season with a muzzleloader. You are restricted to the type of antierless deer printed on the license and must stay in the unit to which the license is assigned.

Can hunters age 14 or 15 (in 2023) with a youth season license who did not harvest a deer during the youth season, hunt the regular deer gun season with this license? Yes, but you are subject to the restrictions listed on the license.

Can hunters age 11, 12 or 13 (in 2023) with an antlerless white-tailed deer license who did not harvest a deer during the youth season, hunt the regular deer gun season with this license? Yes, but you are subject to the restrictions listed on the license.

I was unsuccessful in filling my mule deer buck license in a restricted unit during the youth season. Can I hunt the remainder of the state during the regular gun season? No. You are restricted to the same unit as during the youth season.

I shot a deer, but it is rotten. What can I do? You must take possession of the animal by tagging it. A license only allows the opportunity to hunt. It is not a guarantee to harvest a deer, or to the quality of the animal.

What should I do if I find a wounded deer? Contact a game warden. Do not shoot the deer unless you want to tag it or are instructed by the warden to do so.

Is camouflage blaze orange acceptable for the deer gun season? No. You must wear both a hat and outer garment above the waistline totaling at least 400 square inches of solid daylight fluorescent orange.

I hunt with a bow. When do I have to wear orange? Only during the regular deer gun season.

Can I hunt road rights-of-way? Do not hunt on road rights-of-way unless you are certain they are open to public use. Most road rights-ofway are easements under control of the adjacent landowner and are closed to hunting when the adjacent land is posted closed to hunting.

Can I hunt on a section line if it is posted on both sides? No. If the land is posted on both sides, the section line is closed to hunting, but open for travel.

Can I hunt over bait on private land? It is unlawful to hunt over bait, or place bait to attract big game for the purpose of hunting, in deer hunting units impacted by chronic wasting disease.

Can I take the carcass outside of the unit? The entire carcass can be transported outside of the gun unit where it was harvested. If transported out of the gun unit, the carcass waste (material left after processing) must be disposed of via landfill or waste management provider. This requirement does not apply to heads dropped at CWD collection sites, or lymph nodes submitted for CWD surveillance.

Can I retrieve a wounded deer from posted land? If the deer was shot on land where you had a legal right to be and it ran onto posted land, you may retrieve it. However, you may not take a firearm or bow with you. The department suggests contacting the landowner as a courtesy prior to entering.

What if the landowner says I cannot retrieve a deer from posted land that was shot on land where I had a right to be? Contact a game warden.

Can I drive off-trail on private land to retrieve a deer? Unless prohibited by a landowner or operator, you may drive off-trail on private land once a deer has been killed and properly tagged. You must proceed to the carcass by the shortest accessible route and return to the road or trail by the same route.

Can I transport someone else's deer? Yes, but you will need a transportation permit from a game warden. The license holder, person transporting the animal, and the carcass must be presented to the game warden before the permit is issued.

May I carry a pistol when I am hunting with a deer rifle? Yes, but the handgun must meet minimum requirements listed in the deer hunting regulations to be legal for taking deer.

Can I carry both bow and gun afield during deer gun season if I have both licenses? Yes, but only if you are going to fill your gun license. No firearms, except handguns, may be in the hunter's possession while hunting with a deer bow license. However, handguns may not be used in any manner to assist in the harvest of a deer with an archery license.


