





Late Season Hunting Dates

The statewide duck and white-fronted goose seasons close Dec. 3. However, duck hunting in the high plains unit reopens Dec. 9 and continues through Dec. 31.

In addition, the season for Canada geese closes Dec. 16 in the eastern zone, Dec. 21 in the western zone and Dec. 29 in the Missouri River zone. Light goose hunting closes statewide Dec. 29.

Archery deer, fall turkey, sharp-tailed and ruffed grouse, partridge and pheasant hunting seasons continue through Jan. 7.

The season for tree squirrels closes Feb. 29.

Mountain Lion Zone 1 Late Season Opens

North Dakota's early mountain lion season in Zone 1 closed Nov. 26, and the late season, when hunters can pursue lions with dogs, is open.

During the early season, hunters took six cats from a harvest limit of eight. Under the season structure, a conditional season could open five days after the late season closes for hunters to pursue the additional two mountain lions that were not taken.

The late season in Zone 1 is scheduled to run through March 31, 2024, or until the harvest limit is reached. The late season harvest limit is seven total lions or three female lions, whichever comes first.

Hunters are advised to check the <u>status of the late season</u> by visiting the North Dakota Game and Fish Department website, <u>gf.nd.gov</u>.

Zone 1 includes land in western North Dakota south of ND Highway 1804 from the Montana border to the point where ND Highway 1804 lies directly across Lake Sakakawea from ND Highway 8, crossing Lake Sakakawea, then south along ND Highway 8 to ND Highway 200, then west on ND Highway 200 to U.S. Highway 85, then south on U.S. Highway 85 to the South Dakota border.

The mountain lion season in Zone 2, which is the rest of the state outside Zone 1, has no harvest limit and is open through March 31, 2024.

The mountain lion season is open only to North Dakota residents. Hunters need a furbearer or combination license to participate.

Spending Time with Family and Friends

Ask almost any grandparent, aunt, uncle or older family friend what their favorite part of the holidays is, and you will likely get the same answer from most.... time with family and friends. In other words, nine out of ten older adults say that time with those they love is the best part of their days.

The holidays create the perfect situation for us to spend time with those that mean the most to us. As we age, we realize just how precious those times spent together really are. We might look for ways to connect more often. Many of us live long distances from some or all of our family so those big family gatherings might be limited to only the holidays. Others have mobility impairments that make traveling even short distances very difficult. No one wants to talk about trying to block out a few days in today's busy schedules and competing priorities to drive on icy roads for hours.

Adaptations that we made during Covid taught us new ways to connect without traveling. Technology emerged that made it less daunting to get a group together from all over the world or at least across county lines, in a hurry. Virtual visits took many different forms that all reduced travel time. While a virtual visit will never be as good as face-to-face interaction there is a place for it in overcoming some of the barriers that keep us apart. The roads are never closed on my face time app no matter how bad the snow and wind are

Many devises are constructed with the older adult user in mind. Some are voice operated to make use successful for those with vision impairments. There are also options for those with hearing impairment. Some can be operated remotely by family members wanting to drop in for a visit. The holidays are a great time to help set up a devise in your loved one's home that could help them to connect to others on a more regular basis. Think about what your loved one might enjoy the most. Would they like the ability to video chat using voice prompts? Would they like someone to be able to drop in virtually to make sure that their day is off to a good start? It might be as simple at a picture frame that can have pictures loaded remotely to showcase the activities of those great grandchildren.

Once you know what you are looking for it is time to get started. Some interactive devises like Elli-Q and Alexa Show, allow real time interactions with family members. They also can help with memory by helping to create lists and playing games. There are also options for photo sharing like Skylight and Dragon Touch. These devises allow family members to upload pictures remotely. Most digital options require a wireless internet connection. Many older adults are able to access a discounted rate on internet through the Affordable Connectivity Program. This is a partnership with local internet providers in much of North Dakota and is income based.


