December Holidays and History – December ushers in winter holidays such as Christmas, <u>Kwanza</u>, and Chanukah. It is also a time when families gather in the warmth of their homes. During the twelfth and final month of the year, December inspires a flurry of activity both in the business world and our personal lives. But December is not so somber, peaceful, and busy as to have no fun at all. Holidays like Ugly Sweater Day, Answer the Phone Like Buddy the Elf Day, and National Ding-A-Ling Day add a bit of whimsey.

DECEMBER HISTORY OVERVIEW

The name December comes from the Latin word 'decem' meaning ten. On the Roman Calendar, December was the 10th month. However, Numa Pompilius adjusted the calendar when January and February were added. December became the twelfth month, and the calendar more accurately reflected the length of a year on Earth.

During December, the winter solstice tips the Northern hemisphere its furthest distance from the sun. Through most of the month, its inhabitants lose about 2 minutes of sunlight per day until the winter solstice. The winter solstice marks the start of winter and the shortest day on the calendar. However, from that day forward, the days will slowly lengthen. They may not be warmer, but the Earth is tilting on its axis back toward the sun.

December Holidays and Traditions Overview

December is a big baking month for many. In the United States, families, churches, schools, and organizations bake cookies to exchange. They are often part of the gift-giving and ugly sweater parties that occur right before or during Christmas, Kwanza, and Chanukah.

Those born in December claim three icy cool birthstones. Tanzanite, found only in Tanzania, is a deep glacial purple. Blue Zircon (not to be confused with cubic zirconia) is the oldest mineral on Earth and comes in a variety of colors. However, for those born in December, the icy blue zircon is beautiful. Finally, turquoise, with its distinct color and veins, comes in a variety of shades. Prevalent throughout the Southwestern United States, turquoise also added value and meaning to clothing, ceremonies, and more.

The fragrant narcissus usually blooms in spring. However, for December birthdays, some species bloom in winter. The paperwhite is one, making the narcissus the ideal birthday flower for December. Among its several meanings, narcissus also means hope. During winter, hope is a thing often looked for through the cold, ice, and snow.

In Greek mythology, Narcissus is well known as the attractive young hunter obsessed with his good looks. His obsession later got the best of him when he looked at his reflection in a pond, and upon closer inspection, fell and drown.







Tentative 2024 Season Opening Dates

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department annually provides its best estimate for opening dates to help hunters prepare for hunting seasons.

Dates become official when approved by governor's proclamation. Tentative opening dates for 2024 include:

Spring Turkey	April 13
Deer and Pronghorn Bow, Mountain Lion	Aug. 30
Dove	Sept. 1
Youth Deer	Sept. 13
Sharptail, Hun, Ruffed Grouse, Squirrel, Youth Waterfowl	Sept. 14
Early Resident Waterfowl	Sept. 21
Regular Waterfowl	Sept. 28
Pronghorn Gun	Oct. 4
Youth Pheasant	Oct. 5
Pheasant, Fall Turkey	Oct. 12
Mink, Muskrat, Weasel Trapping	Oct. 26
Deer Gun	Nov. 8
Deer Muzzleloader	Nov. 29

Early Ice Awareness

Outdoor enthusiasts need to be aware of early ice conditions before traveling onto and across North Dakota waters.

A few reminders include:

- •Edges firm up faster than farther out from shore.
- •Snow insulates ice, which in turn inhibits solid ice formation, hiding cracks, weak and open water areas.
- •Ice can form overnight, causing unstable conditions. Ice thickness is not consistent, as it can vary significantly within a few inches.
- •Avoid cracks, pressure ridges, slushy or darker areas that signal thinner ice. The same goes for ice that forms around partially submerged trees, brush, embankments or other structures.
- •Anglers should drill test holes as they make their way out on the lake, and an ice chisel should be used to check ice thickness while moving around.
- •Daily temperature changes cause ice to expand and contract, affecting its strength.
- •The following minimums are recommended for travel on clear-blue lake ice formed under ideal conditions. However, early in winter it's a good idea to double these figures to be safe: 4 inches for a group walking single file; 6 inches for a snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle; 8-12 inches for an automobile; and 12-15 inches for a pickup/truck.

And some life-saving safety tips:

- •Wear a personal flotation device and carry a cell phone.
- •Carry ice picks or a set of screwdrivers to pull yourself back on the ice if you fall through.
- •If someone breaks through the ice, call 911 immediately. Rescue attempts should employ a long pole, board, rope, blanket or snowmobile suit. If that's not possible, throw the victim a life jacket, empty water jug or other buoyant objects. Go to the victim as a last resort but do this by forming a human chain where rescuers lie on the ice with each person holding the feet of the person in front.
- •To treat hypothermia, replace wet clothing with dry clothing and immediately transport the victim to a hospital.

Poinsettias are woody shrubs native to Mexico and can get up to 10 feet tall. Can you imagine having a poinsettia shrub in your yard? That would be the ultimate "wow" factor in your landscape. Sometime go ahead and search online poinsettia shrubs in Mexico to see how amazing they look!

The poinsettias we see today, are the results of many years of breeding and selection. Today's poinsettias have larger bracts, bloom earlier and longer, and are available in many colors such as, but not limited to: cream, pink, purple, peach, and variegated.

If you are gifted a poinsettia or even purchase one for yourself, the care is very easy. Place the plant in indirect light where it will receive around 6 hours of light. Make sure to keep it away from cold or drafty windows and heating vents or doors. The ideal temperature for the plant to have the most vibrant colors is around 65 degrees Fahrenheit. If the plant has foil wrap around it make sure to discard any extra water after giving it a drink. Water when soil is dry.




