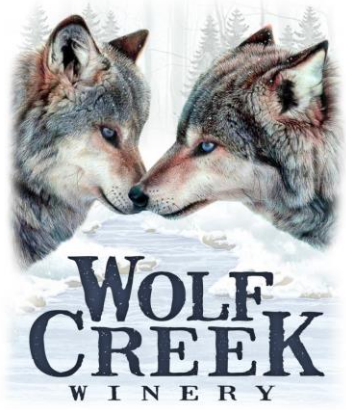
In the late summer of 2022, she added a food trailer to the selection, offering gluten-free comfort foods and handcrafted drinks.

All the food and drinks served in the store and on the food trailer are gluten-free. Maintaining a dedicated gluten-free commercial kitchen, Alisha understands the struggles of those who have celiac or are gluten intolerant, creating a safe space for individuals to enjoy eating old favorites. In-store customers can enjoy delicious waffles, burrito bowls, and a variety of baked goods. 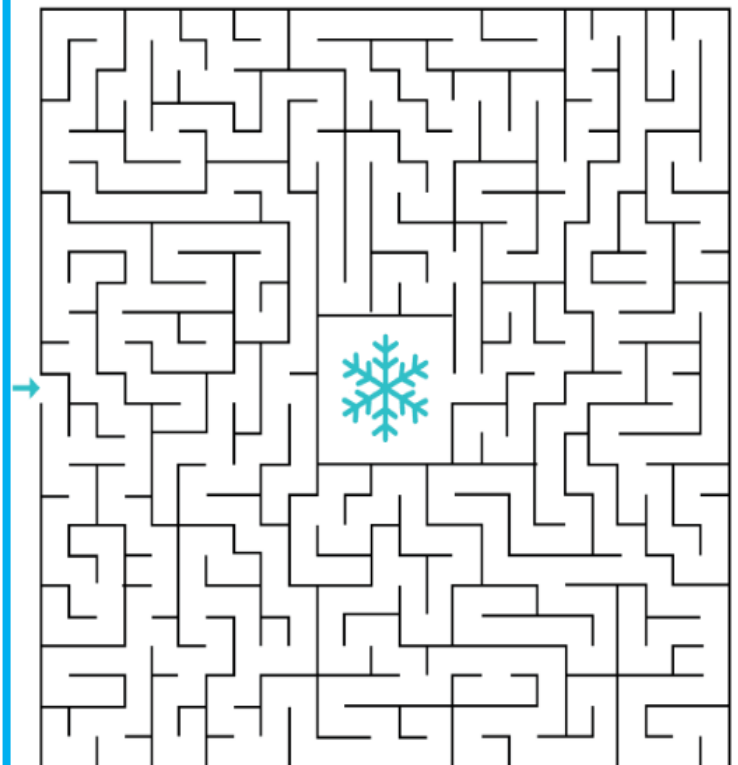

NORTH DAKOTA GAME & FISH

Hunters Urged to Participate

North Dakota hunters receiving a survey this winter are encouraged to help with wildlife management by completing the survey online or returning it to the state Game and Fish Department.

Big game, small game, waterfowl, swan, turkey and furbearer questionnaires are being sent to randomly selected hunters.

It is important hunters complete and return the survey, even if they did not hunt. The harvest survey allows Game and Fish to evaluate the hunting season, to determine the number of hunters, amount of hunting activity and size of the harvest.

A follow-up survey will be mailed to those not responding to the first survey.

Remove Gear from WMAs

Tree stands, blinds, steps, and other personal items such as cameras, must be removed from all wildlife management areas by Jan. 31.

Items not removed by then are considered abandoned property and are subject to removal and confiscation by the North Dakota Game and Fish Department.

Skillet Apple Pie Biscuits

8 frozen buttermilk biscuits thawed or
Easy Cream Biscuits
1 21 oz can premium apple pie filling
1/2 cup butter melted
1/2 cup light brown sugar
1 Tbsp ground cinnamon
1 tsp pure vanilla extract

1/8 tsp nutmeg
1 cup walnut or pecan
pieces optional
Glaze: May double if desired
1/2 cup powdered sugar
2-3 Tbsp cream or half & half



Preheat the oven to 375°F. Melt the butter, and brush on all sides of a 10-inch cast iron skillet. In a bowl, mix together the brown sugar, cinnamon and nutmeg until blended. Dip each biscuit in the butter and sprinkle all sides with the cinnamon sugar mixture. Arrange side by side in the skillet. Cut the apples in the pie filling into smaller pieces and mix in 1 teaspoon of pure vanilla. Arrange over the biscuits. Pour the remaining butter over all and sprinkle the remaining cinnamon-sugar on top. Bake for 30-35 minutes, until golden and puffy. Mix together the powdered sugar and cream until smooth. May double, if desired. Drizzle on top. Serve immediately. Serves 8

Start the New Year with Tasty, Healthful Meals and Cost-saving Tips

The new year has come and there is no better time to look ahead, do a little planning, and find that you can eat healthy and save money at the same time.

Begin with creating a weekly menu; check your cabinets for foods, spices and everything you need; write a shopping list; and head to the grocery store. Consider ways you can add more fruits and vegetables into meal planning and remember to follow the MyPlate portion sizes for adequate nutrition. Taking 30-minutes to plan meals and creating a shopping list, will decrease the amount of time at the store and save you money.

Shop \$mart Ideas

- Avoid grocery shopping when tired and hungry.
- Shop alone if possible and go only once a week. If you shop with family, assign tasks to let them help find items and distract them from the tempting candy, cookie, snacks or toy items.
- Eat a snack before grocery shopping to avoid impulse buys.
- Create your shopping list according to store layout. Only go down aisles that include items on your list.
- Choose fresh fruits and vegetables in season or choose canned, frozen, or dried items that best fit your storage option, lifestyle, and budget.
- Use store apps or coupons to save money.
- Compare unit prices for the same product from different brands. Unit prices are the small labels located on the front edge of grocery store shelves.
- Avoid buying nonfood items (i.e. soap, shampoos or paper products) at the grocery store unless they are on sale.
- Stay alert for checkout counter mistakes. Look carefully at your receipt to make sure you get the correct price.
- Avoid using a credit card unless you intend to pay off the balance each month.

This will help fill your nutritional needs and avoid over or under eating which may help to keep weight down, feel more energetic, and decrease the risks of heart disease, diabetes, and obesity.
