Nancy Bergman's awardwinning luster landscape

The Midstate Porcelain Art Guild was incorporated on August 17, 1979. There were 29 members from Underwood, Garrison, Turtle Lake, Bismarck, Minot and Max. The meetings were held on the first Saturday of the month at whatever place the hostess for that month determined. There was a business meeting and a demonstration given by one of the members. The guild held an art exhibit once a year.

Over the years, the membership has gone down. We currently have members from Coleharbor Underwood, Hazen, Beulah, New Salem, Mandan, Washburn, and Center. The objective of the guild is the same, to promote the fine art of porcelain painting. The guild still meets on the first Saturday of the month, but along with the business meeting, the group paints a project that is led by one of the members. The group has taken on a project of painting coffee mugs which are given to patients at The Bismarck Cancer Center. This is in conjunction with a project of the World Organization of China Painters. Lessons are given to groups who are interested in porcelain painting such as 4- H clubs and schools. Members exhibit pieces at conventions and fairs.

Our group is led by Vida Klocke, a widely known and respected porcelain artist. Vida has taught seminars all around the United States. We are fortunate to have her lead us though projects with new designs, materials, and skills. Vida also is the World Organization of China Painters contact for the upper one third of the United States. Vida also has a variety of You Tube videos on how to paint designs on porcelain. (cont.)

Our Members participate in the World Organization of China Painters Conventions. We have had members serving on committees and working on projects for the conventions for years. This year's convention will be in St. Paul, Minnesota. Members will be exhibiting projects in our ND State table as well as joining painting teachers from around the world in painting classes. Many of our members have had their work featured in the World Organization of China Painters Publication, "The China Painter."

We hold a porcelain painting seminar once a year which is taught by instructors chosen by the guild. The instructors come from all over the United States, and we invite painters from other groups to join us. This year's seminar will be held on May 4-6 in Riverdale. Our instructor will be Nancy Bergman. Nancy is an expert on the use of lusters. She teachers how to use lusters around the world. Nancy used to have a contract with the stores in the Macy's department chain. She designed an ornament and then handmade 5.000 ornaments for the stores each vear. Nancy needed more time to teach and work on a variety of projects. Nancy teaches how to use gold, platinum, and lusters on varieties of projects. You are invited to stop in and see what we are learning when Nancy is in Riverdale.







Grant Application to Assist R3 Efforts

Wildlife, shooting, fraternal and nonprofit civic organizations can submit an application for the <u>Encouraging Tomorrow's Hunters program</u>, a North Dakota Game and Fish Department grant program developed to assist in the recruitment, retention and reactivation of hunters.

The program supports projects and events that provide a positive environment to develop the skills and confidence needed to create lifelong, conservation-minded hunting and shooting sports participants.

Application deadline is May 1.

The maximum grant allowed is \$3,000. The program currently helps fund approximately 40 club and organization events and projects each year, with an average grant of \$1,550.

Funds help cover event expenses, including promotional printing; event memorabilia such as shirts, caps or vests; ammunition and targets; and eye and ear protection.

Past funding has enabled groups to conduct learn-to-hunt events, or sponsor trap and other shooting events, including archery and rifle shooting. Game and Fish has separate grant programs that support National Archery in the Schools Program and high school trapshooting teams.

Clubs or organizations interested in applying should note the grant process, application, and records requirements. Businesses launch impractical or unbelievable products for the fun of the day and newspapers print incredible headlines catching readers off quard.

Of course, the trick to a good April Fools' prank is planning. And you also need to be the first to pull it off. There's no point in pursuing your prank if someone else beats you to it. Once the foolery has been triggered, everyone else will be on high alert and the element of surprise will be lost.

Some practical jokers go to great lengths to pull off their ruse. The more people involved the greater the risk of being discovered before the great plan can be deployed.

APRIL FOOLS' DAY HISTORY

We would be fools to think we knew precisely when April Fools' Day was originally celebrated. However, April Fools Day shares similarities with other days full of fools, tricks, and merry-making.

Some believe the day is celebrated in honor of the trickery Mother Nature plays on us this time of year with her unpredictable weather. Another possible connection is the Indian tradition of Holi. The day is celebrated on March 31st and practices the same foolery as April Fools' Day. So does the Roman festival of Hilaria which was celebrated on March 25th.

The earliest known reference to April Fools' Day is in Chaucer's 1392 Nun's Priest's Tale. Even so, the reference is so vague, and possibly not even occurring on the first of April, leaving doubt as to whether it is the first reference.

Other scholars point to the reformation of the calendar by Pope Gregory and the Gregorian calendar we used today in the 1500s in France. The new year would take place in April, not January as it does now. The theory is that those who continued to celebrate the new year on April 1st were called Poisson d'Avril (April fish) and pranks would be played on them.

In 1582, France accepted the Gregorian calendar, but reforms had already been taking place.

In Britain in 1776, there is a clear and reliable reference to April foolishness in an article in *Gentlemans*

Magazine. Reference to a custom in the kingdom of making fools of people on the first day of April. It addresses the day being the culmination of an eight-day feast and the beginning of a new year.

Noted Foolery

Newspapers, television, radio, and social media have had their fun on April Fools' Day. Check out all this April 1 foolishness:

- •Times of London reported in 1992 that Belgium was negotiating to join Holland.
- •The Evening Star of Islington advertised in 1864 a display of donkeys at the Agricultural Hall the next day. Those who arrived early soon realized who the donkeys on display really were.
- •In 1950, *The Progress* in Clearfield, Pennsylvania, published a picture of a UFO flying over the town. Claiming to have "scooped" larger publications of the first-ever published picture of a real flying saucer.
- •In 2008, the BBC presented a documentary on flying penguins.

April Fool's FAQ

- Q. Is April Fool's Day always on April 1st?
- A. Yes. If your friends, coworkers and the news seems especially goofy on April 1st, this is why.
- Q. Can anyone participate in April Fool's Day?
- A. Yes. Silliness and practical joking are for everyone. It's important not to pull a prank that might be dangerous. Some fun and harmless ways to celebrate include:
- •Slipping a rubber snake, worm, mouse, or other creature into food.
- •Leaving a fake mess for someone to find like plastic puppy droppings or spilled milk.
- •Switch the labels on a few cans of vegetables.
- •Pour gravy over ice cream. Add sprinkles for an authentic look.
- •Stick a sign on your friend's back that says, "Wish me a happy birthday!"
- •Call the local radio station and wish your little sister "Happy 50th Birthday" ten years early.
- •Post on social media that you're moving to a foreign country.




