## **APRIL HOLIDAYS AND HISTORY**

#### **National Day Calendar**

April is the fourth month of the year and consists of 30 days on the Gregorian calendar and its predecessor, the Julian calendar. Its name is derived from the Latin word *aperit*, which means "to open." In the Northern Hemisphere, April is a part of the growing season. The sun warms the earth, awakening the plants and blossoms and leaves "open" bright and new. It is also believed that the month's name is named after the Greek goddess, Aphrodite (Aphros).

April wasn't always the fourth month. Originally, the Roman calendar placed the month second, though it still consisted of 30 days. It became the fourth month consisting of only 29 days when January was designated the first month of the year around 450 BCE. April became 30 days long again when Julius Caesar reformed the calendar.

#### **Weather & Seasons**

April is the second month of spring and on the lips of many is the old saying "April showers bring May flowers." The chilly winds and damp weather are not yet done. April then is a hopeful month showing the promise of beauty in the not too distant future. In the Southern Hemisphere, fall begins.

The Easter holiday most often falls during April. Easter is the commemoration of the death and resurrection of Jesus. Many of the rituals surrounding its celebration have a pagan origin including hiding easter eggs. Eggs are a symbol of fertility and new life.

April's full moon is called the Pink Moon and represents the pink phlox flower that blooms in April. When the Pink Moon is also the first full moon of spring it is called the Paschal moon.

April is also a terrific month for sports. The official baseball season begins. Golf gets into the swing of things, too plus basketball and hockey are in the midst of their regular season. Professional soccer is heading toward season finales.

#### **What's Your Sign?**

Those born in April are either an Aries (the Ram) or Taurus (the Bull). A diamond is April's best friend...we mean birthstone. The birth flowers are daisy and sweet pea.

- 1. April Fool's Day may have originated in France where New Years Day was celebrated during Medieval times on April 1st. When Gregory XIII changed it back to January 1st in 1582, many people in rural areas did not make the change for several years. The cosmopolitan city dwellers thought them fools for this reason, and it became the fashion to take advantage of the naivete of the provincials on this date. The practice spread to England and other English speaking countries.
- 2. April starts on the same day of the week as July and ends on the same day of the week as December in common years. During leap years, April starts on the same day of the week as January.
- 3. Spring cleaning is associated with several cultures but its place in April comes from the Jewish tradition to prepare the home for <u>Passover</u>. It's also part of the Christian tradition in preparation for the first day of Lent.
- 4. How many people do know named April? The name "April" is ranked April is also a popular name given to a lot of people. In the United States, the name April is the 453rd most common name. The United Kingdom ranks the name slightly higher at 278th most common name.

## NORTH DAKOTA GAME & FISH

#### **Paddlefish Tags Online**

North Dakota's paddlefish snagging season opens May 1, and snaggers should note the sale and distribution of paddlefish tags are similar to last year.

<u>Paddlefish tags are available for purchase online</u> at the North Dakota Game and Fish Department's website, <u>gf.nd.gov</u>, at <u>license vendors</u>, and during normal business hours at Game and Fish Department offices in Bismarck, Dickinson, Jamestown, Devils Lake, Lonetree (Harvey) and Williston.

Snaggers buying tags online or at a vendor should plan accordingly and allow for a few days delivery as tags are distributed through the mail.

#### **Deer Gratis Application Online**

Landowners interested in a 2023 deer gratis license <u>must apply online</u> by visiting the North Dakota Game and Fish Department website, <u>gf.nd.gov</u>. The deadline for applying is June 7.

General deer and muzzleloader lottery applications will be available online in early May, also with a deadline of June 7.

Gratis applicants who have previously applied online will automatically have their land description forwarded to this year's application. However, any changes with land descriptions from last year's application must be made prior to submitting the 2023 application.




