Nancy Bergman known by china painters all over the world is considered the most knowledgeable person when it comes to lusters and using precious metals on porcelain pieces. The Midstate Porcelain Art Guild sponsored a seminar featuring Nancy on May 4-6 in Riverdale. The guild welcomed fellow painters from Montana who often join us for our seminars.

Nancy brought pieces to show the different techniques that could be used to create a variety of products with lusters and metals. Painters in attendance used what Nancy taught to create a tile featuring a landscape and a vase with their own design ranging from painting a design, doing a pour with lusters, sponging lusters, and using a marbelizing technique.

Nancy lives near the twin cities in Minnesota. She has traveled all over the world teaching about lusters and precious metals on porcelain. Nancy has her own line of products which she sells to porcelain artists. Nancy had a contract to hand make luster ornaments for the Dayton Department Stores years ago. Nancy's mother and sister helped her complete the 5,000 ornaments for the contract. After having had the contract increased to 10,000 ornaments, they quit after their annual contract was completed. Nancy enjoys traveling and sharing her talents with fellow artists.

Members of the guild hope to include lusters in their projects. Watch for the guild at the Capital Affair. Our members also participate in art shows and in county fairs as well as the state fair. Our members have had their paintings featured in articles in The China Painter, the magazine of the World Organization of China Painters. We also participate in the WOCP World Show and serve on committees that plan the show.

POWER LINE SAFETY ON THE FARM



SAFETY TIPS THAT ARE ALWAYS IN SEASON

- Know what's below. CALL 811 before starting any digging project.
- 2. Always USE A SPOTTER to warn you of any dangers when moving equipment.
- 3. If you strike a guy wire, NEVER REPAIR IT YOURSELF. Call your local utility right away.
- 4. WATER CONDUCTS ELECTRICITY, so be careful when irrigating near power lines.
- Keep yourself and machinery AT LEAST 10 FEET AWAY from overhead power lines.
- Be extra careful when operating sprayers, planters and cultivators.
 KNOW THE HEIGHT AND WIDTH OF YOUR FARM EQUIPMENT to prevent accidental contact.

WHAT TO DO

If a power line falls across or near your machinery while you are in it, stay inside and CALL 911. Tell bystanders to stay away. If you must exit, jump as far as possible, so no part of your body is touching the machinery when you land. KEEP BOTH FEET TOGETHER and shuffle or hop at least 40 feet away.

Be safe.

Equipment is the primary source of horsepower on the farm. It's also tied to the greatest number of severe farm injuries. Respecting and using the equipment properly is vital. Put safety first and everything else second.





NATIONAL MOONSHINE DAY – June 5

National Day Calendar

Every June 5th National Moonshine Day recognizes a beverage with a notorious record of blurring the lines of history and the law, turning ordinary men (and women) into criminals and common criminals into legends.

#NationalMoonshineDay

Moonshine traditionally is an illegally distilled spirit. Mostly made from a corn mash, moonshine is a distilled whiskey that is typically produced by an individual illegally without a permit. Also known as white lightning, mountain dew, homebrew, hillbilly pop, rotgut, and too many more to list here.

Prohibition

Distilling skills first came to the United States with the Scotch-Irish as they settled in Virginia.

Temperance laws and prohibition legislation were passed in several states before the Civil War, but it wasn't until the turn of the century that the temperance movement picked up steam. By the time the 18th Amendment was ratified early in 1919, over half the country was dry.

Prohibition lasted 13 years. It created a demand for moonshine, unlike any that may have existed before. Moonshine became big business overnight.

Modern Moonshine

These days, moonshine in the legal sense has a following. Small-batch distilleries are producing legal moonshine giving moonshiners a new name. Bringing moonshine out of the woods and going up against other whiskeys for a place on the shelf. Many are packaging their homebrews in canning jars, embracing their rich history while at the same time experimenting with flavor and branching out with food pairing similar to that of wine and beer.

Trivia

- •Shepherd was Uncle Jesse's CB handle on the Dukes of Hazzard. Sweet Tillie was the name of his Ford LTD/Galaxie in the first episode his moonshine runner.
- •The X's on the moonshine jugs symbol represents the number of times a batch was run through the still. If marked XXX, the moonshine is pure alcohol.
- •What do Esther Clark, Edna Giard, Stella Beloumant, Mary Wazeniak all have in common? They were all bootleggers. Bootlegging was an equal opportunity profession.
- •Lavinia Gilman was a bootlegger, too. At 80 years old, she ran a 300 gallon still in Montana. The judge suspected her son was the real culprit, though.
- •During prohibition, there were many ways to transport bootlegged moonshine. Faking a funeral was a convenient ruse to move the product. Out of respect for the dead, of course, those with the badge were reluctant to stop a funeral procession.


