This Week in History

June 21

1788 – The U.S. Constitution goes into effect when New Hampshire becomes the 9th colony to ratify it.

1879 – F. W. Woolworth opens his first store in Utica, New York, but it fails the following year. He opened a new store in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, in 1881 and within a few years Woolworth was a millionaire. Woolworth died in 1919 at age 66.

1893 – The first Ferris wheel premieres at Chicago’s Columbian Exposition. It was designed and built by George Washington Gale Ferris. Ferris died of TB in 1896 at age 37.

1939 – The New York Yankees announce Lou Gehrig’s retirement after doctors reveal he has amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS). Gehrig made his farewell speech on July 4th.

June 22

1847 – Elizabeth Gregory creates the doughnut when she makes a large batch for her son’s voyage. She gave the recipe to Captain Gregory’s cook so he could make doughnuts for him and his crew.

1970 – President Nixon signs the 26th Amendment, lowering the voting age from 21 to 18.

June 23

1784 – The first manned balloon ascension in the U.S. takes place when 13-year-old Edward Warren goes aloft in a tethered hot air balloon at Bladensburg, Maryland.

1860 – The U.S. Secret Service is created to combat counterfeiting of U.S. currency. Congress requested that the Secret Service provide protection for presidents after the assassination of William McKinley in 1901.

2013 – Aerialist Nik Wallenda completes a quarter mile tightrope walk over the Little Colorado River Gorge in Arizona.

June 24

1795 – The Senate ratifies the Jay Treaty between the U.S. and Great Britain. It was the first treaty that used arbitration to resolve issues. Negotiated by Supreme Court Chief Justice John Jay, the treaty resolved trading and land issues.

1853 – President Franklin Pierce signs the Gadsden Purchase (29,670 square miles) from Mexico (now southern Arizona and New Mexico) for \$10 million.

1940 – TV cameras are used for the first time in a political convention as the Republicans convene in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

June 25

1876 – George Armstrong Custer and his 7th Cavalry (262 men) are wiped out by the Sioux and Cheyenne Indians at Little Big Horn in Montana. In 1863, Custer (age 23) was appointed a Union Brigadier General. He graduated last in his class from West Point in 1857.

1968 – Bobby Bonds of the San Francisco Giants hits a grand-slam home run in his first game with the Giants. He was the first player to debut with a grand-slam home run. Bonds died in 2003 at age 57.

June 26

1870 – The Christian holiday of Christmas is declared a federal holiday in the U.S.

1974 – The Universal Product Code (UPC) is scanned for the first time to sell a package of Wrigley’s chewing gum at the Marsh Supermarket in Troy, Ohio.

1977 – Elvis Presley sings in Indianapolis, Indiana. It was the last performance of his career. Presley died on August 16th at age 42.

June 27

1778 – The Liberty Bell is returned to Philadelphia from Northampton Town (now Allentown) where it was hidden until after the British depart following the Revolutionary War.

1893 – The New York stock market crashes. By the end of the year, 600 banks and 74 railroads had gone out of business. This is why the period of time following the stock market crash of 1929 is called the “Great” Depression.

1940 – Robert Pershing Wadlow’s height is measured at 8’ 11.1”, making him the tallest person in history according to Guinness World Records. The Illinois native has a shoe size of 37AA. He was only 22 at the time of his death on July 15, 1940.

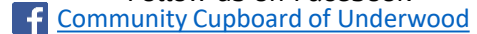

Oven-Baked Shotgun Shells

INGREDIENTS

- (2) 8 oz. boxes manicotti shells
- 1 ½ lb. ground beef
- 1 lb. Hot Italian sausage
- 1 medium onion, finely diced
- 2 c. Colby jack cheddar cheese
- 6 oz. cream cheese
- 1 jalapeno, finely diced
- 2 tsp. Slap Ya Mama seasoning
- 2 tsp. garlic powder
- 2 tsp. black pepper
- 1 tsp. red pepper flakes
- (3) 12 oz. pkgs. Bacon
- 1/3 c. barbecue sauce, plus more for coating



DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 300 degrees and line a baking sheet with aluminum foil. Place a wire rack on top of the baking sheet. Set aside. Mix all ingredients in a large bowl, except bacon and extra barbecue sauce. Gently stuff uncooked manicotti shells from both ends. No air pockets. Wrap bacon around each shell covering the ends (might need two pieces of bacon). Brush additional barbecue sauce over both sides and place on prepared baking sheet. Bake for 60 minutes, then flip shells over, add more barbecue sauce and bake for another 60-70 minutes or until the bacon is nice and crispy. Remove from the oven and enjoy. Serves 28.

Tips When Launching, Loading Boats

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department encourages boaters to plan accordingly when launching and loading a boat. Here are a few simple reminders to ensure a fluent transition at the ramp.

Launching

- Don't pull onto the ramp until your boat is ready to launch.
- Prepare for launching in the parking area. Remove covers, load equipment, remove tie downs, attach lines and put in drain plug before backing onto the ramp.
- When ready, pull in line to launch. Wait your turn. Be courteous.

Loading

- Don't block the loading area with your boat until your tow vehicle is ready to load. Wait until you are clear of the launch area to unload gear.
- As soon as your trailer is in the water, load and secure your boat to the trailer.
- Remove boat and trailer from the water as quickly as possible.
- Get clear of the ramp. Pull into the parking area to finish securing your boat, unload gear, drain all water and inspect for and removing any vegetation. Remember to leave plugs out when transporting your boat.

Bait Regulations

Anglers should note that live white suckers are not legal baitfish in North Dakota, except in the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers.

Anglers can use live white suckers on the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers, and tributaries up to the first vehicular bridge; however, they are illegal elsewhere. Fathead minnows, sticklebacks and creek chubs are the only legal live baitfish outside of the Bois de Sioux and Red rivers.

The transportation of live white suckers, other than in Richland, Cass, Traill, Grand Forks, Walsh and Pembina counties, is illegal.

In addition, it is illegal for anglers to import minnows and other forms of live aquatic bait, such as leeches and frogs, into North Dakota.

When purchasing live aquatic bait, anglers must buy from a licensed North Dakota retail bait vendor. Bait vendors can properly identify species and ensure all bait is clean of any aquatic nuisance species.

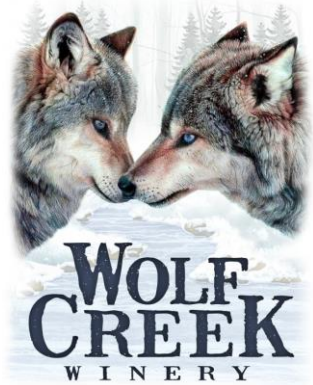

POWER LINE SAFETY ON THE FARM



SAFETY TIPS THAT ARE ALWAYS IN SEASON

1. Know what's below. CALL 811 before starting any digging project.
2. Always USE A SPOTTER to warn you of any dangers when moving equipment.
3. If you strike a guy wire, NEVER REPAIR IT YOURSELF. Call your local utility right away.
4. WATER CONDUCTS ELECTRICITY, so be careful when irrigating near power lines.
5. Keep yourself and machinery AT LEAST 10 FEET away from overhead power lines.
6. Be extra careful when operating sprayers, planters and cultivators. KNOW THE HEIGHT AND WIDTH OF YOUR FARM EQUIPMENT to prevent accidental contact.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU CONTACT A POWER LINE:

If a power line falls across or near your machinery while you are in it, stay inside and **CALL 911**. Tell bystanders to stay away. If you must exit, jump as far as possible, so no part of your body is touching the machinery when you land. **KEEP BOTH FEET TOGETHER** and shuffle or hop at least 40 feet away.



Be safe.

Equipment is the primary source of horsepower on the farm. It's also tied to the greatest number of severe farm injuries. Respecting and using the equipment properly is vital. Put safety first and everything else second.

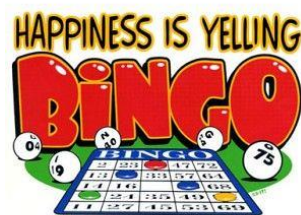

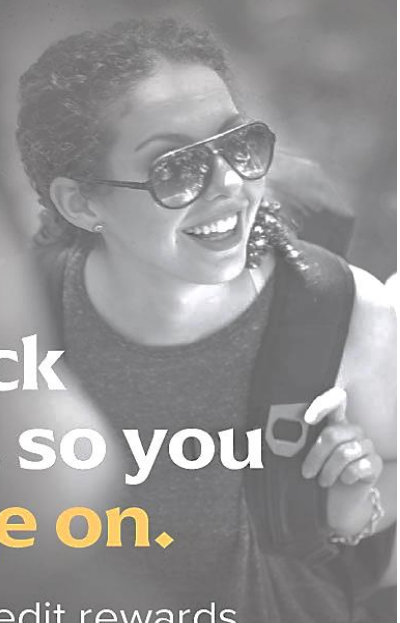
