City of Pick City Meeting minutes -January 10, 2025

Present: Kel Westman, Lori Davis, Brandon Reiser, Scott Bather, Arvid Anderson.

Also present: Consultant, Amy Ones and Auditor Diane Johnson.

Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order at 4:00pm

Motion by Westman, second Davis to approve the consent items bills, agenda and minutes of the 12-4-24 meeting. All in favor.

Motion by Reiser, second Westman to have Auditor contact Western Health on concerns of a Health & Nuisance property within the city limits. All in favor.

Motion by Westman, second Davis to approve a 5% cost of living raise to city employees, council all agreed that they, personally did not want a raise. Motion carried.

Motion by Westman, second Davis to cap Medical insurance reimburse to \$700.00. All in favor.

Motion by Reiser, second Westman for the first reading of the amendments to Chapter 15 Building Code ordinance. Upon Roll call vote: All council members voted aye. Motion carried

Motion Reiser, second Bather for the first reading of Residential property with Water shut off to be amended to the water ordinances. Upon Roll call vote: All council members voted aye. Motion carried.

Ordinance shall Read as follows:

Residential property with water shut off: Residential properties are required to have water supplies to be determined as able to occupy full-time. If a property has had their water turned off due to failure to pay, the owners will have 30 days to resolve this issue and have their water restored. If they continue to occupy the residence, the appropriate state health department will be notified to address as a health concern issue.

Consultant, Ones recommended to the council that they reach out to our legislators and/or attend the legislation Hearing (1/17/25) pertaining to the SB2097 Rural endowment Fund Bill.

Bather wanted feedback on having a celebration in 2026 in honor of America turning 250 years old. Everyone thought it was a great idea. Need to set up a planning committee and ask the public if interested in planning.

Landfill will be burnt in the near future.
