Mayor Anderson called the meeting order January 3, 2023 at 7:30 pm.

Council Present: Arvid Anderson, Lori Davis, Kel Westman, Scott Bather. Absent: Reiser.

Other present: Jim Sailer, Diane Johnson & Vernon Herman.

Bather motioned, second Davis to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on Dec 5, 2022 & the special meeting on Dec. 19<sup>th</sup>. All in favor.

Old & New Business:

- Received an email from MC Tax Director regarding Odin Anderson's vacated property. His deed
  has been recorded & she will let him know. Mayor asked residents for comments on the request
  from Odin, regarding purchasing more vacated property from the City. Herman thought if the city
  sells property to one resident, they should do it for all residents. Council tabled the issue until
  they meet with Odin Anderson.
- City will set up an account with Bisman online to advertise the City1979 Dump truck, by sealed bids, Jim will be the contact person.
- Christmas Party is set up for January 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:00.
- Council gave permission to have a Vendors Show at the City Park in July. This will be a fund raiser for the Fire Department.
- Davis motioned, second Westman to approve the first reading of Ordinance 1.0201.

(Regarding Meeting day change) 'No specific time between 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> reading is needed according to our attorney.' Motion carried.

- Bather motioned, second Westman to approve the substitution of security from USB in the amount of \$20,000.00. All in favor.
- Davis motioned, second Bather to accept Pat Drown's resignation taking effect on Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Motion carried.
